NAME OF THE CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is Central Park Gardens of Davis

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

- A. Central Park Gardens of Davis is a non-profit PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to create and maintain beautiful public landscapes, to motivate and educate the public about sustainable gardening, to provide educational programs, and to serve as a model for community involvement through volunteer activities.

ARTICLE V

EXEMPTION REQUIREMENT

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for public education and charitable purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section

501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Tax Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI

PERSONAL LIABILITY

To the fullest extent allowed by California Law, no member, officer, or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers or directors be subject to the payment of debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII

DISSOLUTION

A. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to education and charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person, except that this Corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

B. Upon the dissolution of this organization, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed for public education or charitable purposes to an organization which is exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the City of Davis, for the purpose of supporting community parks
