

What kinds of flowers attract **butterflies**?

- The narrow, tubular flowers of a butterfly bush provide butterflies exclusive access to nectar which they can sip with their long straw-like proboscis
- **Coneflowers** and other **daisies**, provide a landing platform for butterflies as they slurp nectar.
- Flowers that produce nectar in spring and summer provide essential food for butterflies.
 Wallflowers are good spring nectarproducers.
