

What kinds of flowers attract **butterflies** ?



- The narrow, tubular flowers of a **butterfly bush** provide butterflies exclusive access to nectar which they can sip with their long straw-like proboscis

- **Coneflowers** and other **daisies**, provide a landing platform for butterflies as they slurp nectar.



- Flowers that produce nectar in spring and summer provide essential food for butterflies. **Wallflowers** are good spring nectar-producers.
